WOMEN'S FOOTBALL CAPTAINS

BLUES ORIGINALS LEADING THE WAY

Women's football captain and utility player Georgia McCullagh is into her ninth year at the club but "was pretty much born here."

Her earliest memories include being looked after by the Grahams and O'Keefes while her dad 'Gambler' was playing, on and off the field, with best mate and club legend Mark 'Tokka' O'Keefe. Tokka's daughter Emma, a Blues netball legend in her own right, remains to this day an inspiration and 'life coach' for Georgia.



Georgia can't help but take the Emma and Tokka competitiveness with her whenever she runs out in the Navy Blue.

"While I like to try and do a bit more thinking off-field during the week, Hannah is more cool, calm and collected during the game".

The 'Hannah' Georgia refers to her is her 2024 co-captain, Hannah Utri, who will also be directing traffic in the ruck.

Hannah is relatively new to the game.

"I played pretty much everything at school and at university in Melbourne – basketball, netball, swimming", all sports her German grandparents would be familiar with. Less so our great game, but having joined the club in 2021, Hannah is one of the Senior Women's OG's –

a distinction she shares with Georgia.

There is an obvious connection between the two leaders. They are relishing the opportunity of bringing out the best from their young list, blessed with many Blues junior graduates, as well as ensuring that the sense of fun our senior women's football team is known for continues.

Looking ahead, Hannah hopes for a season of "positivity and togetherness", complemented by Georgia's old-fashioned O'Keefe ethos of "having a crack". The duo are loving what Georgia describes as "the new vibe" at the club, where the inclusive "embrace we feel from the boundary line, in a once male-dominated sport, encourages us to get more involved (in the club)."

There is something for all of us in that.

FOR WHOM THE BELL TOLLS

Isaac Hemmingway's classic Spanish Civil war novel won him a Nobel Prize and immortality among literati worldwide.

In anyone's language that was a big win ... and who doesn't love winning. But it's not everything.

Just ask twins Grace and Ruby Bell. At the tender age of 24 they have played more than 325 games combined for the Blues.



Ruby celebrated her 150th last week with a strong win over rivals South. Grace got to that milestone a year or two ahead of Ruby, who missed a season with a ruptured ACL as a junior.

Yet to win a flag in their 13 years in the Navy Blue, the attacking mid-courter (Grace) and defender (Ruby) find plenty of enjoyment at the club elsewhere.

None more so than at the social functions. "We are always there", says Grace. "I guess because we know everyone", chimes in Ruby, finishing her sister's train of thought.

Yet that desire to win burns deep. After finishing near the bottom of the ladder in Division 2 last year, their Division 3 side is sitting third at 4-1. "I think this is the year. I've called it early", laughs Grace.

It was indeed Grace who came early ... or at least 15 minutes ahead of Ruby.

Perhaps unsurprisingly, the twins have never played in different teams.

One team. One club. One Blue family – a living embodiment of a club value. Club stalwarts Marli and Kyle have filled Committee, President and Board roles. Aunt Gen Howland is a long-term player and umpire. Brother Ryan played senior and reserves football, while oldest brother Jackson is currently senior men's football co-captain.

Grace and Ruby are part of two families ... and yet perhaps really only one. The genes of clan weave smoothly in their case into the fabric and culture of club.

And a club is so much more than the on-court skills that the twins bring to us each week.

In Hemingway's own words, "For what are we born if not to aid one another."

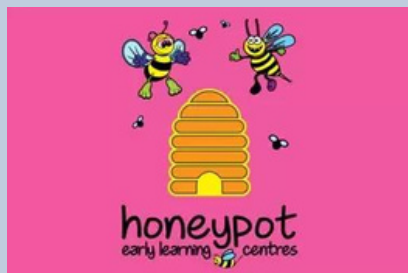
It's a tight competition this year, and I'm excited to watch the open side rise to the challenge presented to us each week.

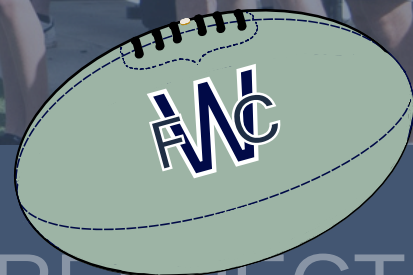
